Cibolo Parkway Extension

Cibolo City Council Meeting – March 8, 2016

In 2015, the Cibolo City Council instructed the City Manager to explore options to extend FM 1103 to SH 78 and to IH 10.

The extension and realignment of FM 1103 to IH 10 was conceived in 2006 and was incorporated into Cibolo's Future Land Use Map & Future Thoroughfare Plan and our Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) over the last ten years.

Development of a high-capacity roadway passing through the City of Cibolo that connects Interstate Highway 35 with Interstate Highway 10 may enhance public transportation and provide needed connectivity between two of the nation's major transportation corridors.



Furthermore, the Cibolo Turnpike Parkway will include the construction of an overpass over Union Pacific Railroad tracks and SH 78; thereby, improving emergency vehicle response times by affording Police, Fire, and EMS first responders access to both sections of the city.

The northern end of the 7.1 mile long extension starts at the existing intersection of Wagon Wheel Way and FM 1103. The roadway will extend south through a proposed “greenfield” route (undeveloped property) and connect to IH 10 at the existing Zuehl Road overpass.

The proposed right-of-way width is 150-feet. This right-of-way width is designed to accommodate up to three traffic lanes in each direction with a raised median.



SECTION 1.3 DUTIES OF THE BLUE RIBBON COMMITTEE

The Blue Ribbon Committee will act as an advisory group to the Mayor and City Council on recommending the feasibility of pursuing a proposed Cibolo Turnpike Parkway extension of FM 1103 from Wagon Wheel Way to Interstate Highway 10. On completion of the Committee, the Committee will be required to provide a written recommendation to the Cibolo City Council.

SECTION 1.4 ORGANIZATION, MEETINGS AND TERM

The members of the Blue Ribbon Committee shall elect a Chairman and Vice Chairman at their first meeting. All meetings will be held at Cibolo City Hall at 6:30 p.m. Multiple meetings per month may be required as this committee term shall only be for approximately 60 days. Term of the Committee will begin when members have been selected and appointed by City Council. The Chairman shall preside over the Committee when in session and may vote on all matters. The Vice Chairman will preside in the absence of the Chairman.
